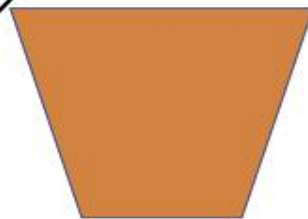
I wonder how Jesus thought the mustard seed was like faith? I wonder what the mountain could be? I wonder what that might look like in your life?

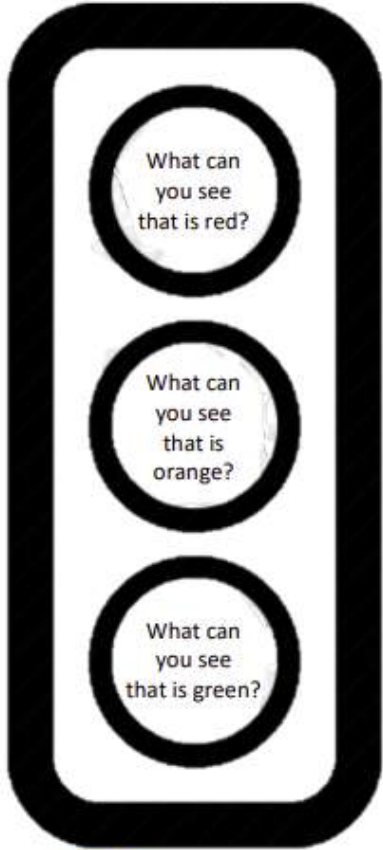

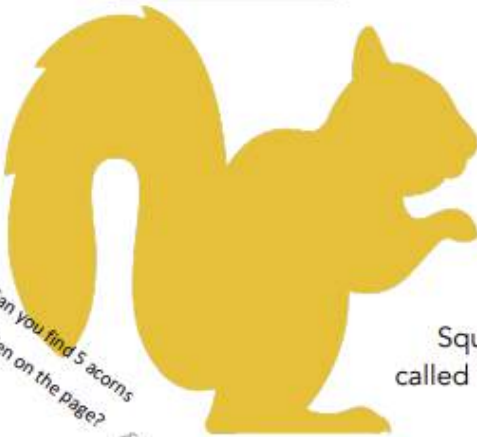
Sometimes changes or new things can be really exciting, I wonder if the trees worry about their leaves changing?

Can you find 5 acorns hidden on the page?

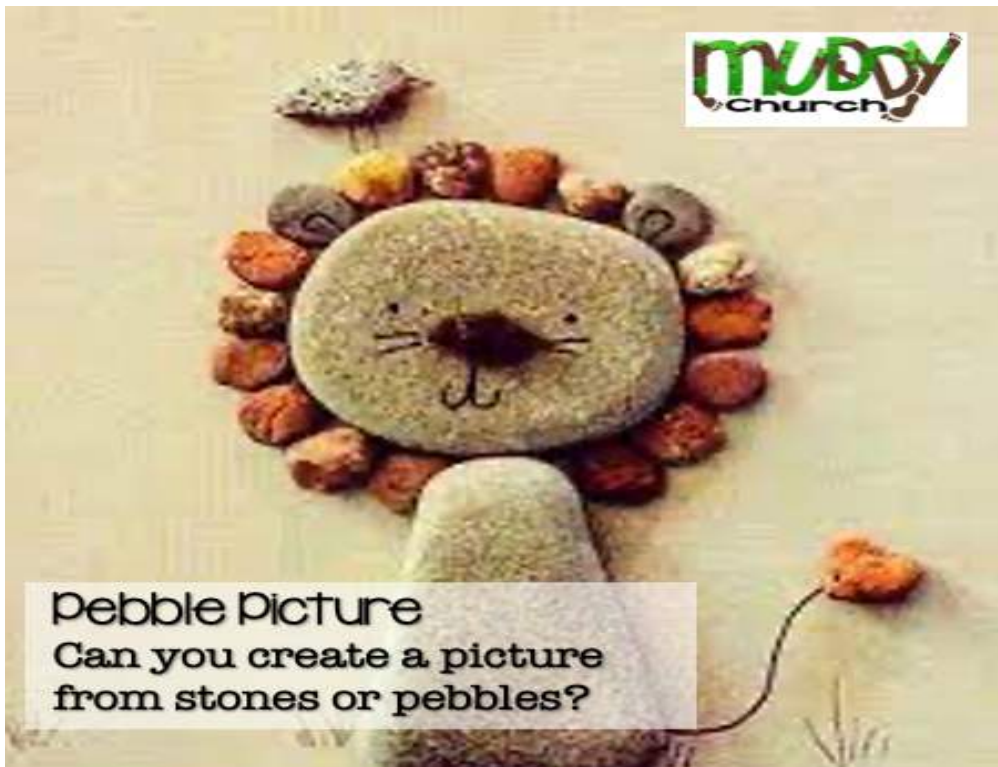
